## Head Teacher Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

### NEU (National Education Union)

Some of you may have received a leaflet at the gate from an NEU representative a few weeks ago. Although, I am not at liberty to discuss the details, I do want to reassure you that many of the matters listed in the leaflet are fabricated.

As parents you are fully aware of the number of staff who leave at the end of each year. We normally have 2 or 3 members of staff leaving which is not unusual and they have left to further their career or to work closer to home all very valid reasons. There has been no mass exodus of staff at our school as stated in the leaflet.

It is important to note that we do not have over 30 pupils in a class and instead have composite classes this year and next year. A composite class is where you have a mixed year group for example Year 3 and Year 4. However, these children are taught separately and are rarely together at any point of the day. So again this is untrue.

Also as a Trust we continue to follow the model pay policy developed by Waltham Forest and we are guided by this. All teachers are paid in line with this and NO staff member has left our school due to a lack of 'pay rises'. All pay rises are given in line with government directive on pay increases. If you have any concerns about the leaflet I am happy to address this.
