Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to remind you that Mayville Academy strives to be as nut free as possible. This means that no nuts or nut-containing products should be brought into school in packed lunches, snacks, or any other food items.

We have children in our school community with **severe nut allergies**, and even small traces of nuts can cause a serious allergic reaction. By keeping our school environment nut-free, we can help ensure the safety and wellbeing of all pupils.

Please avoid sending:

- Peanuts, tree nuts, or mixed nuts
- Peanut butter or Nutella-style spreads
- Cereal bars, cakes, biscuits, or snacks containing nuts
- Pesto or sauces containing nuts
- Any other products listing nuts as an ingredient

If you are unsure whether a product contains nuts, please check the ingredient list carefully.
