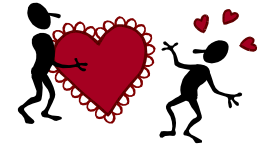

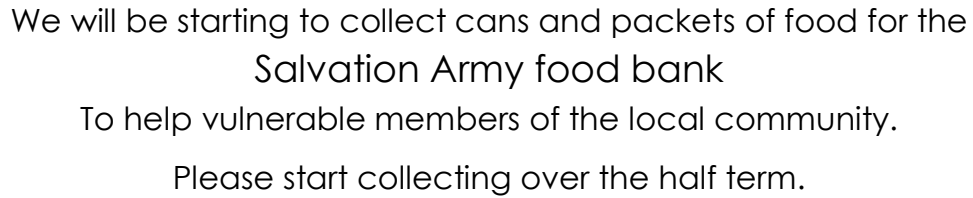

1. Go into Apps on your mobile phone and search E4education. Bluestone Creative Limited will come up. Click on this and install the free app.
2. On the screen you will see the methods of finding the right school. Put in the postcode of the school – E11 4PZ. Mayville will come up. Click onto it to access it.
3. Once installed, the app will show in your phone as School News and appear as an orange square with a large number 4 in it.
