
Is there a situation in your life you don't know how to deal with or would like help with.

- 1. Go into Apps on your mobile phone and search E4education. Bluestone Creative Limited will come up. Click on this and install the free app.
- 2. On the screen you will see the methods of finding the right school. Put in the postcode of the school – E11 4PZ. Mayville will come up. Click onto it to access it.
- 3. Once installed, the app will show in your phone as School News and appear as an orange square with a large number 4 in it.
