Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am delighted to be writing to you as the newly appointed Interim Head teacher of Mayville Primary school. I feel extremely honoured and privileged to have been chosen to continue and build upon the success the school has already achieved. Having worked in education for 30 years in various roles, I thoroughly understand what is needed to take the school forward in this new era of education.

I am aware that some parents are understandably nervous about the changes in personnel and the impact this will have on standards at Mayville Primary. I think it is crucial to involve the children and their families as partners in their education. I am also keen on building a whole school community, which thrives on mutual respect and values positive relationships.

As key educators in your children's lives, I feel that it is important that you feel you have a voice and that as a school we are approachable and allocate time to listen to your concerns, worries or thoughts about the school. I will be holding termly coffee mornings, in which parents/guardians can chat to both myself and the senior leadership team to express opinions on what the school is doing well and/or any areas that may need addressing. You can be assured that as Head teacher, I will strive to create the best education for your child/children whilst they are members of our school family.

I believe that we will have a positive and successful future, working, growing and developing together as a whole school community so that Mayville Primary is a school that children love coming to and one which provides an all-round educational experience in which everyone can flourish.
