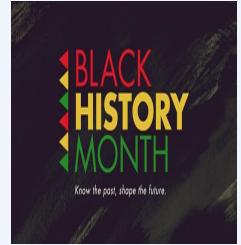

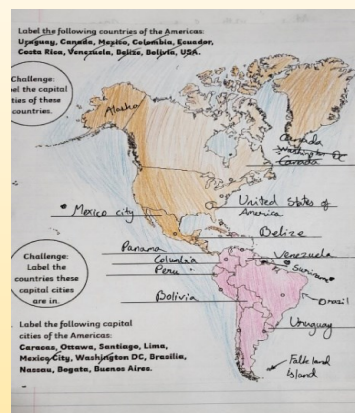

Year 6 Learning Geography

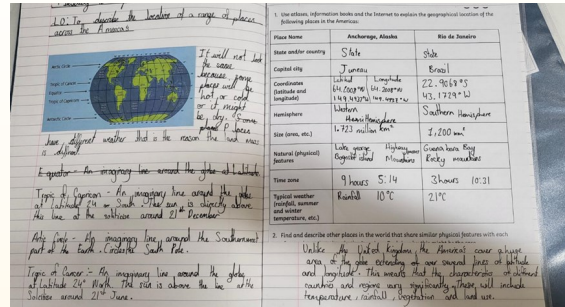
In Geography this term, we are learning about The Amazing Americas.

We have been using atlas, maps, and Google maps to identify the location of different countries and states. We also learned how to use longitude and latitude to locate the countries and cities.



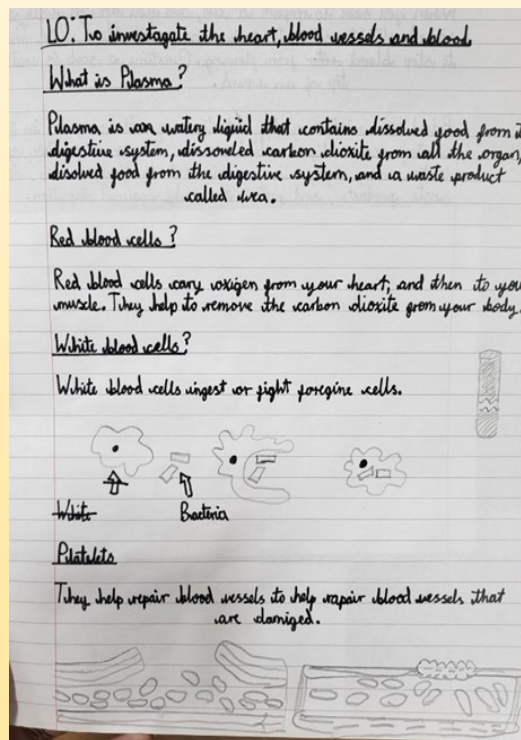
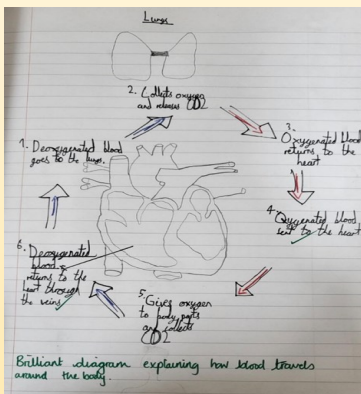

In Science this term, we are learning about the circulatory system. We have been exploring the function of the heart and how blood travels from the

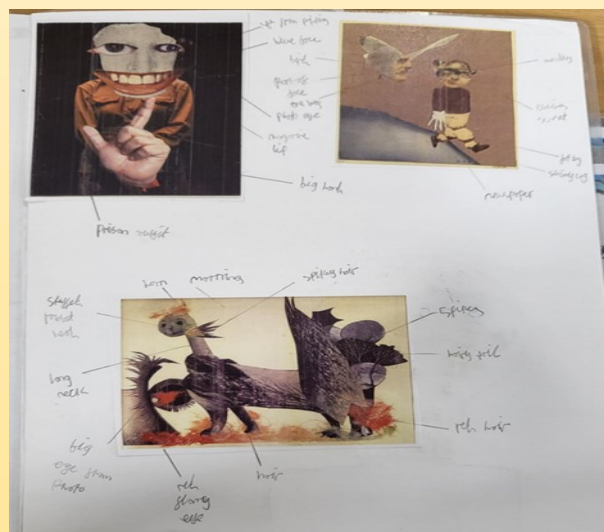


We also investigated the different components that make up our blood and what their main roles are. We used a range of resources to make blood and investigated what happens if we were to have an open wound.
