Multiplication and Division

- Recapping 3, 4, and 8 times tables
- Comparing multiplication statements
- Multiplying and dividing by 10
- Multiplying by multiples of 10 (30, 50, 60 etc)
- Multiplying 2 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers
- Dividing 2 digit numbers using mental strategies.
- Dividing using short division
- Solving reasoning problems relating to these strategies.

Length and Perimeter

- Comparing, adding and subtracting lengths.
- Measure and calculate perimeter.
- Measure in cm, mm and m.
- Learn about equivalent lengths.

French: The date and celebrations

- Make links between some phonemes, rhymes and spellings-Observe a French calendar-Read the names of the days of the week-Place the days in chronological order-Learn a nursery rhyme with the days
